DANCE RULES

All students must be aware and follow the following rules governing all WHS Dances:

1. All students and their parents must sign a contract in order to purchase a ticket.
2. No student/guest will be admitted after 8:30PM.
3. No student/guest will be allowed to leave before 9:00PM. In an emergency, administration will contact parent.
4. Only Westminster High School students may purchase dance tickets.
5. Guest tickets may be bought only by WHS students. One guest per student. Guests are high school students who do not attend WHS or individuals out of high school, but no older than 20. No other guests are allowed. Each guest must enter the dance at the same time as the WHS student. The WHS student is responsible for his/her guest and for seeing that the guest abides by all WHS school and dance rules. Failure to abide by school/dance rules may result in removal from the dance and disciplinary action for the student/guest. Changing guests is not allowed. Changes may cause attendees to be turned away at the door. The name on the contract must match the name on the ID card of the guest. WHS administrators have the right to approve or reject guest contracts.
6. Students/guests who leave early will not be allowed to return for any reason.
7. Students must have acceptable discipline and attendance histories with no outstanding Saturday Schools (see Supervision for clearance).
8. All school rules apply at dances. Use and/or possession of cigarettes, vapes/e-cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, and weapons are prohibited.
9. No moshing, break dancing, or freaking. WHS staff will always monitor student dancing.
10. **For this dance – No sweats, PJ's, flip-flop or slippers will be admitted.** All regular dress code rules apply for both students and guests during any school activity. Students and their guest will be denied access to the dance if the dress attire is considered too revealing or inappropriate at the discretion of school administration. Garments that reveal excessive cleavage, halter tops, tube tops, short shorts, or short skirts, low rise garments must not be more than two inches from the waist, bathing suit tops, see-through clothing, and undershirt tank garments (male & female) not allowed. Any clothing, which allows underwear to be exposed, is also prohibited. The district prohibits clothing that shows or conveys messages of a sexual tone, including but not limited to obscene symbols, signs or slogans. Sexually suggestive clothing is disruptive to the school environment. Clothing or items that advertises or advocates weapons, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, violence or any other racial, ethnic, sexual, or religious put-down is not permitted.
11. No bookbags or backpacks or bags/purses are allowed and will not be admitted.
12. Students need to bring their student ID for dance check in. If you do not have your student ID, please go to the activity office for a replacement ID card for \$5.00.
13. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER TICKET PURCHASE FOR ANY REASON!

Additional Specific guidelines include:

- All students/guests will be subject to search.
- All vehicles may be inspected for alcohol/drugs/weapons.
- Students/guests will be randomly breathalyzed. If there is reasonable suspicion that they may be under the influence of alcohol they will be breathalyzed.
- Any person using, possessing and/or under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, and/or weapons will be detained until parents and/or police are notified. Students will then be subject to disciplinary action the next day following the event.

- Members of school groups/sports teams must be aware that any infraction of the rules governing the use of alcohol/drugs may be grounds for suspension or removal from the group/team.
- Seniors must be aware that any infraction of school rules may prevent them from participating in senior activities and the graduation ceremony.
- All students violating school rules may be prevented from attending future school activities and dances.

1. Pick up contract in Activities Office (G1) or print from www.whslions.net
2. WHS students must complete required information and must have parent/guardian signature.
3. Non-WHS guest in high school must complete required information and attach a photocopy of their school ID card. Non-WHS guest not in high school between the ages of 17-20, must provide a copy of driver's license or California ID.
4. Submit contract to the Activity's Office for approval prior to purchasing your ticket if you are bringing a non—WHS guest.
5. The WHS student bringing a guest, needs to check back in with activities to confirm guest approval.
6. Approved contracts may be taken to the Finance Office or any ticket table where tickets are purchased.
